Our service is marked by the lighting of new fire from which the Paschal Candle is lit, symbolizing Christ's Resurrection light in the midst of the world's darkness. The parish hall will be open after the service for sherry and Easter sundaes. Help us further enrich this ancient and festive celebration by joining us at 7:30 p.m. Saturday evening. Childcare will be provided.

You are invited to **BRING A BELL TO RING TO CELEBRATE THE RESURRECTION** at the Easter Vigil service on Saturday, April 20, at 7:30 p.m. and on Easter Sunday at 9 a.m. and 11 a.m.

**SERVICES ON EASTER SUNDAY** are at 9 a.m. and 11 a.m., both with choir. A nursery will be provided for the 9 a.m. Easter Sunday service, and a Coffee Hour will follow both Easter Sunday services. No Church School or adult classes are scheduled for Easter Sunday.
