


87 NEW LEADERS TRAINED



We hosted our second Meaningful Change Leadership Intensive. We trained 45 leaders in October. We trained another 42 new leaders in January! We have 15 Core Teams built or being built among 20 congregational members. We now have 10 leaders who have led trainings! We have identified another 8 solid potential leaders for future trainings. We are getting a critical mass of leaders who have been strong leaders in this community for many years...yet now we are getting organized!

The next training will be in May. Future leaders will learn:

Organizing for Change: How to inspire and mobilize people for meaningful community change.

Engaging Political Leaders: Skills and practices for effectively influencing policy makers.

Crafting Effective Communication: Crafting your powerful story for media, face to face meetings, giving testimony.
